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Notification of New Abortion Reporting Requirements

Senate Bill 1304 ([SB1304](#)) establishes new abortion reporting requirements by amending Title 36 Chapter 20, adding Article 2. The new requirements become effective **July 29, 2010**.

The bill describes reporting requirements for the following:

- 1) hospitals or facilities in Arizona where abortion procedures are performed.
- 2) health professionals who provide medical care or treatment provided resulting from complications of an abortion or an attempted abortion.
