A. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Hoffa called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

B. ROLL CALL

C. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

D. Review, Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Recommendations for Statutory Amendments made by the Committee on ARBOPA Statutes, Rules and Board Processes

The Board received and reviewed the Committee's January 9, 2015 Teleconference Minutes, and discussed the Committee's recommendations for proposed amendments to A.R.S. § 32-2507 and 32-2523 specifically regarding the change to biannual birthdate for license renewals.

MOTION: Chairman Hoffa moved to adopt the Committee's recommendation regarding A.R.S. § 32-2507, as proposed.

E. Review, Discussion and Possible Action on Board Representation to Arizona Legislature

The Board noted that Mr. Goodman has represented the Arizona Medical Board in the past, and Chairman Hoffa commented that Mr. Goodman is very effective in his representation of the Board. Ms. Crevier questioned whether Mr. Goodman would be appointed to represent the ARBoPA permanently, or if the appointment is only for the upcoming legislative session. Chairman Hoffa indicated that Mr. Goodman would represent the ARBoPA for the current legislative session, and Chairman Hoffa added that if the ARBoPA finds itself at odds with the Arizona Medical Board, Mr. Goodman would not be representing the ARBoPA.

MOTION: Chairman Hoffa moved to retain Mr. Goodman for representation of the ARBoPA for the current legislative session for the purposes of the proposed legislative changes.
