NON-TIME SPECIFIC ITEMS

I. LEGISLATIVE AGENDA AND UPDATE

The Board discussed the recently amended Senate Bill 1345. Board members expressed their disappointment regarding language that had been removed from the Bill as a result of the recent amendments made by the Senate. The Board noted that the amended Bill was passed by the Senate, and that it will move forward for approval by the House, and then to the Governor. Board members acknowledged that this is part of the political process, and several members commented that this is a good step forward in the progression of the Board and the PA profession. PA Whitfield proposed requesting that the Chairman draft a letter to the State Senator expressing the Board's appreciation for the efforts made on behalf of the ARBoPA thus far, to indicate that the Board intends to continue to pursue remedies that will strengthen the position of the ARBoPA in the future, and that the Board appreciates the Senator's support in that regard as well. PA Hoffa stated that he has thanked the Senator on behalf of the Board in their interactions, and that without any objection from the Board, he will continue a positive dialogue with the Senator.
