Medical Board Adjudicates Cases Involving 53 Physicians

During its one-day meeting on April 14, 2010, the Arizona Medical Board resolved 58 cases involving 53 physicians.

The Board accepted a proposed Consent Agreement for surrender of a license. It ordered one Decree of Censure with a practice restriction and one Letter of Reprimand with a practice restriction. The Board issued seven additional Letters of Reprimand. Another physician was placed on Probation.

The Board gave non-disciplinary Advisory Letters to 20 physicians and ordered additional non-disciplinary Continuing Medical Education hours for six licensees. The Board dismissed the cases against three physicians and upheld the Executive Director's dismissal of cases involving seven others.

The next board meeting will be held on June 9, 2010.
